About 15 children from Nomzamo and 15 children from Smartie Town attended the weekly clubs. With the help of our volunteers, Mandy Scott, Baby Girl Mpiko, Doreen Herbert, Amelia Van Heerden and Joey Chan, the children enjoyed all the activities they did.

### Needlework Club

Needlework Club is every Friday morning during the school term.

The ladies made blouses, tops, dresses, skirts, drawstring trousers and belted coat jackets.

At the end of the year each lady received a certificate for completing the Halli Trust Machine Sewing Course.

#### Educational Involvement

**After 2 weeks** of doing a **Halli Visit at Gordon's Bay Primary** school for the **Grade R learners**, they were still singing our songs that we did at the school and were colouring in our Halli pictures, it's gives us great gratitude to see and hear the impact we have on our young generation!

We had the opportunity to visit **Fundi Rainbow Educare Centre** again in August 2023 and what stood out for us is that the children remembered everything that was taught to them with the previous talk, Body Preventive Talk in 2022! During the talk of Love, Respect and Bully, Heidi asked a few questions, and the children took the opportunity to speak out about how wrong it is to disrespect, to bully and about what is right and wrong! It was heartwarming for us to see, if children know what it is to respect, not to bully and can distinguish between right and wrong, what about us adults? The world will be such a better place if we all stand together in **peace and harmony!**

We visited **Vlottenburg Primary School** on the 1<sup>st</sup> of November 2023, and it was our first time at the school. We ended our year off with a bang! As it was the last visit for the year. The school welcomed us with friendly warm smiles and children were just amazing! We cannot wait to visit the school again!

#### Community Involvement

Our Community Representative **Gloria Hungana** gave a grocery parcel to a **lady in Nomzamo** through an acquaintance and said that she was so grateful for the parcel as it came in at the right time for her

One of our **Community Representatives, Gloria Hungana** has a client in Nomzamo, who collects tins to bring in a little income to put food on the table. She needs provide for her daughter and granddaughter. We have assisted this family for a while now with groceries, toiletries, clothes etc. Her daughter applied for jobs regularly, and she was out of town when a friend of hers handed her CV in to her employer, who was impressed with her. The employer was so impressed that she was willing to wait for her to come back home to come in for the interview, who then got the job. With work being so scarce these days, it's very scarce that something like this happens! We were delighted with this news because this extra income will help her mother provide!

Our hearts are always filled with **gratitude** when we hear stories of families, we've helped, find employment! One of the fire victims we helped were so grateful for the help they received from Halli Trust; they have notified us that the father has found employment.

We are super thankful for the meaty bones we received from **Deon and Monica Le Roux**, and **Andre du Preez**! It came just at the right time! One of our Community Representatives, Anastacia Molaoa sent us a message of the response she got from the families she helped in the community, *"the meat came at the right time! People were so excited as most of them said they were clueless of what to cook these days! Month end is too far as the cupboards were all empty!"*

We were able to bless **28 families** in Macassar and Nomzamo with groceries and they were extremely grateful. One lady said that this parcel will be a tremendous help as she was not working and had no income. Angeline, who we also assisted, was in tears when we dropped off her grocery parcel, she just stood with her hands on her face saying, "how did we know?" just before we got there, she and her brother was talking about what are they going to eat that evening.

We were able to buy **new school clothes and stationery for 9 children** in December 2023 till February 2024. They were able to start their school career in 2024 with great confidence.

One of our Community Representatives found out about a young man who was in dire need. Odwa, who was all by himself with no support from friends, family, or parents, and was **striving to finish his school career and getting his Matric**. In 2024 he was redoing Grade 11, even though he was 22 years old! We managed to rebuild his shack and blessed him with groceries, cleaning material, toiletries, clothes, linen, kitchenware, and towels. We did a plea to assist Odwa and the response was amazing! KFL Logistics sponsored him with new school clothes, school shoes and tekkies. Sunitha Govender sponsored his school stationery. We have started the process to help him with emotional support. Odwa is looking forward to the future with a bright smile on his face!

### **Additional Community Involvement**

**Halli Club Smartie Town's Leaders** has blown us out of our shoes with their loyalty! Four of our **leaders** had to attend rugby practices and even though it had gone over the time for **Halli Club**, they still came and ready for the session! We are so proud to call them our Halli Leaders!

We have decided to go and support the **Helderberg Rugby Club** on 10 June 2023 as they have chosen to have the Halli Trust logo on their jerseys. The energy was high when our Halli Leaders made a tunnel for the 1<sup>st</sup> team to run through. Halli, our mascot had the privilege to lead the team out. Congratulations was in order as they had won the game.

**Carla Horn**, from Pneumatix did her practical for her dancing teachers' hours with us. The Halli Club children in Nomzamo thoroughly enjoyed the dancing lessons with her so much that when they said their goodbyes, the children were in tears! Carla says that she's ever **grateful for the opportunity** to be able to work with such amazing children and that they have touched her heart!

One of the **Halli Club children** in Nomzamo wrote us a letter about how inspired she was. With all the love, care and comfort she receives from us makes her want to strive to be a great mother one day. She says in the letter that we must never leave her and that we must always be together.

Some of our **Halli Club children** wanted to **give back!** When our Halli Trust Bus broke down, it had cost us almost R40 000 to repair and we had just enough funds in our bank account to pay it, but then it would have left us with almost nothing. When we shared the news, it touched the little hearts of a few girls from our Halli Clubs in Smartie Town and Nomzamo to start selling sweets and chips to bring in funds for Halli Trust to contribute towards the bill.

We celebrated our CEO's birthday on 26 August 2023, and what made it extra special for her is how the some of the Halli Club children in Nomzamo had all come and put their monies together and gave Heidi a **surprise party!** One of them said, "Halli trust always gives us so much and now we want to do something special for her too"

**Our Needlework Club** had their show-and-tell show on November 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2023. They have gotten a new name, and the group is now called the "Alumni". They have made the most beautiful garments for themselves, and we will miss them!

We had a great **party bash** on Saturday 25 November 2023 at Lourensford with both **Halli Clubs** Smartie Town and Nomzamo! Due to weather conditions, we were forced to shift our 13<sup>th</sup> Birthday (17 September) celebrations to November and then decided to celebrate everything in 1 day! We also then did our Certificate ceremony and handed out Attendance certificates for Halli Clubs, Reading Club and Homework Club. We also announced our New Leaders for 2024. It was a day filled with fun and lots of love!

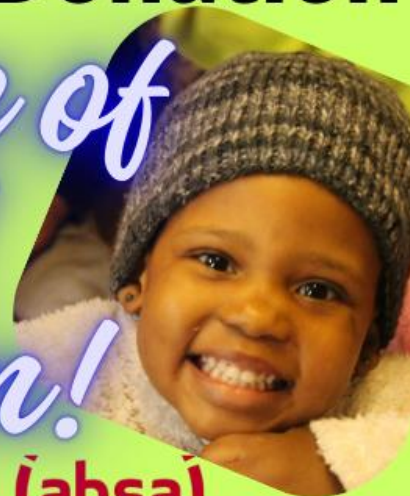
