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## Practical Guide in Preparation for a Halli Visit

To help ensure a smooth and successful visit, please take note of the following guidelines from the Halli Trust Team:



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### Age Group & Group Size

- Suitable for children aged **4 years to Grade 5**.
- Older children may be included based on **emotional maturity** and engagement.
- Preferably **groups of up to 500–600 learners**.
- For groups **smaller than 20 children**, we suggest inviting another school to join.



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### Before We Begin

- Please **do not have the children seated waiting** upon our arrival. Let them continue playing or stay engaged while we set up.
- We begin with **music and interaction** before introducing Halli the mascot, to help children feel at ease.
- **Never force children** to hug Halli or pose for photos — we believe in gentle encouragement.



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### Venue Requirements

- We cannot operate in direct **sun, rain, or strong wind**.  
- Please provide a **shaded or indoor space** for the visit.
- The program lasts approximately **1 to 1.5 hours** and includes:
  - Dancing

- Singing
- Fun, interactive learning
- Life skills and emotional education



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## Teacher Involvement

- Teachers and staff play a key role in maintaining **discipline** during the program.
- Please encourage learners to be **respectful and engaged**.



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## Neurodiversity Inclusion

- Our program caters to both **neurotypical** and **neurodiverse** children.
- For children with **autism (low support needs)** – they can participate fully.
- For children with **high support needs**, we offer a **dancing-only program**, currently available only in the **Helderberg area**.
