With these guidelines we want to inform you of a few practical tips from the Halli Team as you prepare for our visit to your school

Visit to your School:

We ask that the children **do not sit ready and wait for us** as we arrive. We want the children to be busy or play while we get everything ready for the visit on arrival at your school and while setting up

Children must be **between 4 years – Grade 5** – the little ones are too scared of Halli and it is important to us that the children build a relationship with our mascot

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Never force children to give Halli a hug or to stand next to him - we prepare the children well before Halli comes out with music

The **oldest children** can be about Grade 5 depends on the emotional matureness of the children. We can do visits with the older children depends on how "cool" they are

We prefer **smaller groups**, we can rather come twice to your school (\pm 500- 600 in a group or smaller) If you only have about 20 children or less invite another school to join in as its better for the little ones if there are more children

We **cannot** stand in the sun please! Our program is between 1h00 – 1h30 and we do not want the children to sit in the sun, wind, rain when we do our Halli Visit.

The **time frame** is about 1h00 – 1h30 for the program – it is an interactive program with dancing, singing, and having fun with the children but to **EDUCATE** them on important issues of life

The teachers must please assist us with **discipline!**

It is very important to us that the children show us **respect** and take part in the program

Most important **enjoy the time** that we spend at your school with us. You are welcome to give us feedback, because it is important to us to develop and improve our program

Our Halli Visits caters for neurotypical children and for neurodiverse children **BUT** for children with autism with low support needs. We can visit children with autism with high support needs but with a different program (dancing only with our mascot – please speak to us) and only in the Helderberg area.
